Here are some highlights from 2025...

- 3 salvations

- Celebrated the 2nd anniversary of Living Waters Baptist Church
- Consistently have around 30 people attending our Sunday service
- Seen spiritual growth in four individuals that either Brettney or I disciple on a weekly basis.
- Many answers to prayer and provisions for our family and our ministry

These are some big things we are praying about for 2026...

- A big blessing our family has to share is that we are expecting another baby due to arrive in June! Brettney is 16 weeks along, and so far, all has gone smoothly. We will find out the baby's gender later this week. We would greatly appreciate prayers for continued health and safety for mama and baby.
- We will begin our application for permanent residency at the first of the year. This is a huge step for our family! To save \$10k, we have decided to file ourselves without the aid of a solicitor. Pray for wisdom as we gather necessary documentation and fill out paperwork. Also pray God will provide the \$20kAUD (\$13kUSD) required to apply.
- We seek to see Living Waters Baptist Church officially constituted as an independent church. We are currently designated as a ministry of Nepean Baptist church which is in the nearby town of Penrith. Constituting the church would allow us to do several things including setting up church governance, getting tax exemption status, and be able to have more freedom to do certain activities in our city without having to go through the other church. Nepean Baptist has been an enormous help to us and we couldn't have a better relationship with them! We are looking forward to this next chapter and how it will stretch the faith of our people.
- Both sets of our parents, as well as my oldest brother and his wife, plan to visit in 2026. To say we're thrilled is an understatement! When moments together are few, they become even more precious.
